## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Draft Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Council Directive 91/477/EEC on control of the acquisition and possession of weapons (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 19 November 2015 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the 1. Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 27 April 2016<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 15 March 2017. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>

- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
  - approve the European Parliament's position as set out in PE-CONS 62/16 as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with the Czech, Luxembourg and Polish delegations voting against;
  - order that the statements in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
