## **'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) No 531/2012 as regards rules for wholesale roaming markets (First reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 15 June 2016 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 19 October 2016<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 6 April 2017. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.

- 4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
  - approve the European Parliament's position as set out in PE-CONS 7/17 as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with the Croatian, Cyprus, Greek and Spanish delegations voting against;
  - order that the statements in the <u>addendum</u> to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
