- 1. On 29 April 2020 the Commission sent its proposal¹, based on Article 100(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The European Economic and Social Committee has been consulted and is set to reply shortly.
- 3. The Committee of the Regions has been consulted and is set to reply shortly.
- The European Parliament will adopt its position at first reading on the Commission proposal 4. at its plenary on 13-16 May 2020.

- 5. Given the urgency entailed by the exceptional circumstances justifying the proposed measures, it will only be possible to adopt the Regulation via the written procedure.
- 6. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is invited to decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/556², that the Council uses the written procedure:
 - for the adoption of the draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) 2017/352, so as to enable managing bodies or competent authorities to provide flexibility in respect of the levying of port infrastructure charges in the context of the COVID-19 outbreak, as set out in document PE- CONS 15/20³; and
 - to derogate, on the basis of the second subparagraph of Article 3(3) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, from the eight-week period referred to in the first subparagraph of that Article.
