Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on the energy performance of buildings (recast) (first reading) - Adoption of the legislative act

- 1. On 15 December 2021, the <u>Commission</u> submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 194(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 23 March 2022².
- 3. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 30 June 2022³.
- 4. The <u>European Central Bank</u> delivered its opinion on 16 January 2023⁴.

- 5. On 12 March 2024, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal⁵. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the <u>Council</u> approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 102/23, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Italy</u> and <u>Hungary</u> voting against and <u>Croatia</u>, <u>Poland</u> and <u>Slovakia</u> abstaining.
- 7. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the <u>Addendum</u> to this note.
- 8. If the <u>Council</u> approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted⁶.
- 9. After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
