Subject:	Draft Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on addressing the deficiencies identified in the 2016 evaluation of the Republic of Malta on the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of data protection

1. Following the Council's adoption of Regulation (EU) No 1053/2013 establishing an evaluation and monitoring mechanism to verify the application of the Schengen acquis, a team of experts from the Member States and the Commission carried out an evaluation of the application of the Schengen acquis in the field of data protection by the Republic of Malta in 2016.

2. In accordance with that Regulation, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation designed to address the deficiencies identified in the course of that evaluation and ensure that the Republic of Malta applies all Schengen rules related to data protection correctly and effectively.

3. The Working Party for Schengen Matters (Evaluation), including the Mixed Committee partners Norway, Iceland, Switzerland and Liechtenstein, approved the proposal for the Council Implementing Decision setting out a Recommendation on 13 April 2018.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to recommend that the Council adopt the draft Council Implementing Decision, as set out in 8291/18, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
