E. ADDITIONAL ISSUES

11. This conference provided an opportunity to highlight, discuss and resolve queries on the Rapid Response Questionnaires and on the MS contributions to the Rapid Response Databases, in particular classification, commitment degrees and readiness options.
12. The EUMC emphasises that, with the aim to enabling a better use of the MS trained and certified capabilities, the double-hatting of MS contributions for the EU RR databases and other international commitment (e.g. NATO Response Force) is permitted in the EU. In accordance with Ref. A, double-hatting should be indicated as a remark in the MS Rapid Response contributions.
13. In addition, the EUMC invites all MS who possess Gendarmerie Forces to consider contributing those forces to the Land Rapid Response Databases.
14. The EUMC invites all European Multinational Initiatives/Formations developed on a bilateral or multinational basis to consider contributing to the Land Rapid Response Databases. Within this approach, the leading MS will be the one responsible to make the initial offer to the Database. Furthermore, it is acknowledged that these initiatives add value through training and develop interoperability, and may add RR capacity if contributed to the Land RR Database.
