The SCA held an exchange of views on the revised mandate enshrined in documents 7990/17 and 8215/17 + ADD 1 and 2.

The SCA took note of the comments provided by the delegations and by the Commission. Taking into account the delegations' comments, the Presidency suggested some modifications in the mandate (doc WK 4699/2017) and launched a consultation till 25.04 cob.

During this consultation, a number of delegations expressed their opposition in particular to the chapter dealing with controls (Chapter Va) and unpacked products (Article 25(5b)). The Presidency therefore considered that it had no mandate on controls and unpacked products in view of the next trilogue on 3 May 2017.

4. Organisation of future work

The Presidency informed the SCA about the next SCA meeting on 15 May 2017 and the "Agriculture and Fisheries" Council on 11 May 2017. The PL and LT delegations requested AOB items to be tabled at that Council meeting¹.
