Subject:	Draft DIRECTIVE OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Directive 2008/106/EC on the minimum level of training of seafarers and repealing Directive 2005/45/EC on the mutual recognition of seafarers' certificates issued by the Member States (first reading)
	- Adoption of the legislative act

- On 24 May 2018 <u>the Commission</u> sent the above proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 100(2) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. <u>The European Economic and Social Committee</u> delivered its opinion on 12 December 2018<sup>2</sup>.
- 3. <u>The Committee of the Regions</u> was consulted.

- 4. On 4 April 2019 the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.
- 5. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 39/19, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
