Subject:	Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL establishing the Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (first reading)
	 Adoption of the Council's position at first reading and of the statement of the Council's reasons

- On 13 June 2018 the <u>Commission</u> sent its proposal¹, based on Articles 78(2), 79(2) and 79(4) TFEU, to the Council.
- 2. The <u>Committee of the Regions</u> delivered its opinion on 9 October 2018².
- 3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 17 October 2018³.
- 4. The <u>European Parliament</u> adopted its position at first reading on 13 March 2019⁴.

- 5. On 1 March 2021 the European Parliament's Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home <u>Affairs (LIBE)</u> confirmed the provisional agreement and its chair sent a letter on 2 March 2021 to the chair of Coreper declaring that the European Parliament should, at its second reading, approve the Council's position at first reading (following a legal-linguistic review) without amendments.
- 6. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> confirmed on 10 March 2021 the provisional agreement reached by the co-legislators.
- 7. The <u>Permanent Representatives Committee</u> is therefore asked to suggest that the <u>Council</u>⁵ adopt its position at first reading, as set out in document 6486/21 + REV 1 (ro), and the statement of reasons, as set out in document 6486/21 ADD 1, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting, with <u>Hungary</u> voting against and <u>Austria</u> abstaining.
- 8. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum 1 to this note.
