Statement by the Commission

The Commission recalls that under the Interinstitutional Agreement on Better Law-Making of 13 April 2016 the European Parliament, the Council and the Commission agreed that in order to swiftly and correctly apply Union legislation in the Member States, the time limit for transposition of directives would be as short as possible and, generally, not exceed two years.

In view of the particular timeframe for the application of Directive (EU) 2016/97 and of the Delegated Regulations adopted under this Directive, which resulted in difficulties for small and medium-sized insurance companies and insurance distributors to implement the required changes in time for the application date of 23 February 2017, the Commission exceptionally submitted a proposal to amend Directive (EU) 2016/97 by setting the date for application to 1 October 2018.

The co-legislators have also agreed to postpone the transposition date for Directive (EU) 2016/97 to 1 July 2018. The Commission considers that this cannot be interpreted as creating a precedent, as it must be ensured that all Member States are treated equally, but notes that exceptionally it will not stand in the way of this agreement. The Commission expects Member States to fully comply with their obligation to bring their national transposition measures into force at this date at the latest, in order to give insurance companies and insurance distributors enough time to finalise their preparation and adaptation measures with the full knowledge of the European and national legislative frameworks.

<p>Statement by the Commission</p> <p>The Commission welcomes the adoption of the Council Decision authorising the Commission to negotiate on behalf of the European Union an international legally-binding instrument under the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea on the conservation and sustainable use of marine biological diversity of areas beyond national jurisdiction.</p> <p>However, the Commission maintains its view that – in the absence of a draft text at this stage – Article 218(3) and (4) provide a sufficient legal basis for the Decision, without any substantive legal basis being necessary, nor even possible to be determined on the basis of objective factors, taking into account the aim and the content of the agreement. In addition, since the negotiations in the intergovernmental conference concern primarily "the conservation and sustainable use" of marine biological diversity in areas beyond national jurisdiction, they are likely to cover issues which go beyond any single policy area, without it being possible to determine at this stage which policy area would be predominant in the sense of the Court's jurisprudence. In any event the Commission cannot agree on the limitation of the legal basis to a single policy area (environment) while leaving out other possible policy areas. The final text of the international legally-binding instrument shall determine, in any case, the legal basis for its approval by the European Union.</p> <p>Furthermore, the Commission does not consider it appropriate that the Council Decision specifies that the Union can participate in the negotiations only as regards matters "for which the Union has adopted rules" and emphasises that the provisions of the Council Decision authorising the opening of negotiations shall be interpreted in full consistency with the provisions of the Treaties and of relevant jurisprudence and cannot in any case unduly restrict external EU competences.</p> <p>The Commission also recalls that, in accordance with the jurisprudence of the Court, as reflected in Cases C-459/03 (point 94) and C-600/14 (points 62 and 63), the existence of the Union's external competence with regard to a shared competence is not in principle contingent on the adoption of measures of secondary law covering the area in question.</p> <p>The Commission reserves its right to make use, if necessary, of all the legal means at its disposal to ensure the respect of the provisions of the Treaties.</p>
