The Mission of Norway to the European Union refers to the adoption of the following Regulation by the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union:

 Regulation (EU) 2018/1726 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 November 2018 on the European Agency for the Operational Management of Large-Scale IT Systems in the Area of Freedom, Security and Justice (eu-LISA), and amending Regulation (EC) No 1987/2006 and Council Decision 2007/533/JHA and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1077/2011.

In accordance with Article 8 (2) (a) of the Agreement, the Misson of Norway to the European Union hereby notifies, on behalf of the Government of Norway, that Norway has accepted the content of the said Regulation.
