### NOTE VERBALE

The Mission of Norway to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and the European Commission and has the honor to refer to the Agreement concluded by the Council of the European Union and Iceland and Norway concerning the latter's association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen acquis, signed on 18 May 1999.

The Mission of Norway to the European Union refers to the adoption of the following Regulation by the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union:

- Regulation (EU) 2018/1726 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 14 November 2018 on the European Agency for the Operational Management of Large-Scale IT Systems in the Area of Freedom, Security and Justice (eu-LISA), and amending Regulation (EC) No 1987/2006 and Council Decision 2007/533/JHA and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1077/2011.

In accordance with Article 8 (2) (a) of the Agreement, the Mission of Norway to the European Union hereby notifies, on behalf of the Government of Norway, that Norway has accepted the content of the said Regulation.
