<u>The Council</u> approved its position at first reading, with <u>the Spanish delegation</u> abstaining and <u>the German and Austrian delegations</u> voting against, in accordance with Article 294(5) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union. The Council held a policy debate on the proposed Directive for the reduction of national emissions of certain atmospheric pollutants, which is part of the "Clean Air Programme for Europe". The Commission's proposal establishes emission reduction targets so as to reduce the number of premature death in 2030 by at least 50%. While Ministers could support this objective in principle, a majority of them called for more realistic and feasible commitments.

In particular, while some Member States, pointed to technical aspects and to the need to continue with assessing the impact of the proposal and the data discrepancies on specific sectors with respect to the Commission's analysis, other Member States clearly spelled out the difficulties in achieving the reduction in the emissions of specific pollutants and/or in specific sectors. For many Member States the emission reduction targets are not sufficiently realistic especially with respect to dust and ammonia, and/or are too close to the "maximum reductions technically achievable" according to the cost/benefit analysis.

Among the possible solutions, Ministers mentioned the introduction of a flexibility mechanism to modify the targets in case of unforeseen developments in the long term linked to the economic situation (including the agricultural sector), or to the evolution in the energy mix (household heating/urban areas). Some considered that, for the time being, the 2030 objectives should only be indicative, with a possible review in 2020. Other Ministers, however, underlined the need to preserve binding targets and warned that too much flexibility could put at risk the goals of the Directive.

9933/15 ADD 1 **DPG** EN A majority of Member States welcomed the proposal to leave methane out of the scope of this Directive, as stated in the current Presidency compromise text. This responded to concerns about possible overlaps with commitments related to greenhouse gas emission reduction targets.

<u>The Commission</u> stated that methane should be kept in the scope of the proposal. It also confirmed that it would help in finding some solutions to the problems highlighted in the debate, as long as modifications would apply horizontally and without lowering the ambition level of the proposal. The Presidency supported the Commission on this last point, while recalling that targets should also be realistic and feasible. Written contributions to the debate can be found in doc. 9930/15.
