PROCEDURE FOR AGENDA ITEM 2

In accordance with the Council's Security Rules, only delegates with a valid Personnel Security Clearance (PSC) certificate for access to EU classified information at least up to **SECRET UE/EU SECRET** level and a need-to-know may be admitted to a meeting where classified information is to be discussed.

A maximum of 2 participants per delegation can attend the S-UE/EU-S item in JL 70.4. Please make sure you arrive 15 minutes in advance.

- full surname(s), given name,
- nationality,
- date of birth, and
- name of the organisation/institution they represent

b) PSC certificate

Admission to the discussion under this item will be granted only to those delegates for whom the GSC Safety and Security Directorate has a record of a PSC certificate or who can present a valid, original PSC certificate issued by their National Security Authority or by other competent national authorities.

Only in case a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by National Security Authority or other competent national authority, or your organisation's security officer to security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu also by **9 January 2026**.

It is in the interest of the participants to ensure that their PSC certificate has not expired.

Please note that PSC certificate sent by the delegates themselves will not be accepted.

During the discussion of the **SECRET UE/EU SECRET** agenda items, all electronic devices must be left in the lockers outside the meeting room.
