STATEMENT BY HUNGARY

ON THE PROPOSAL FOR COMMON POSITION AT

THE 4TH SESSION OF THE OTIF AD HOC COMMITTEE ON LEGAL AFFAIRS AND INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

18-20 APRIL 2023

Hungary recognizes and promotes equality between men and women in accordance with the Fundamental Law of Hungary, and the primary law, principles and values of the European Union, as well as commitments and principles stemming from international law. Furthermore, equality between women and men is enshrined in the Treaties of the European Union as a fundamental value. In line with these and its national legislation, Hungary interprets the concept of 'gender' as reference to 'sex' – referring exclusively to women and men – in the document Common Position at the 4th session of the OTIF Ad Hoc Committee on Legal Affairs and International Cooperation, 18-20 April 2023 (set out in document ST 7918/23).
