Request for the consent of the European Parliament

 Delegations are informed that the written procedure, opened by CM 2680/21 of 14 April 2021, was completed on 19 April 2021 and that all delegations agreed to adopt the Council Decision on the signing (question (1)) and to request the consent of the European Parliament (question (2)).
