**b) PSC certificate**

Only in case a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by National Security Authority or other competent national authority or your organisation's security officer to [security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu) also **by Wednesday 3 June 2026, 12:00<sup>4</sup>**.

It is in the interest of the participants to ensure that their PSC certificate has not expired.

Please note that PSC certificate sent by the delegates themselves will not be accepted.
