*Only in case* a PSC certificate for the delegate concerned has not yet been transmitted to the GSC Security Clearances Office, a copy should be sent by National Security Authority or other competent national authority or your organisation's security officer to [security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu](mailto:security.clearances@consilium.europa.eu) also **by Wednesday, 5 November 2025, 14:30<sup>6</sup>**.
