At its meeting on 27 October 2021, the Permanent Representatives Committee <u>agreed</u> with the intention of the Commission to sign on behalf of the EU the Joint Statement Supporting the protection and sustainable management of the Congo Basin forest at the 26th UNFCCC Conference of the Parties (COP26), as set out in document ST 13251/21.

The Committee decided to make use of the written procedure for the <u>Council's authorisation</u> to sign the declaration.

Therefore, all delegations are invited to expressly state if they agree:

that the Council authorises the Commission to sign on behalf of the EU the Joint Statement Supporting the protection and sustainable management of the Congo Basin forest at the 26th UNFCCC Conference of the Parties (COP26), as set out in document ST 13251/21 and that if further adjustments to the bracketed text of the non-binding instruments are required, those parts may be adapted accordingly provided that the changes do not affect the substance and intent of the text or the changes consist in agreeing one of the alternative formulations of the draft texts.

Any unilateral statements should be made at the same time as answering the question, except for those already made at the Permanent Representatives Committee.
