**'I/A' ITEM NOTE**

Subject:	Council Decision appointing two members and an alternate member, proposed by the Czech Republic, of the Committee of the Regions - Adoption

---

1. By letter of 14 November 2022<sup>1</sup>, the Secretary-General of the Committee of the Regions notified the Council of the end of the mandate on the basis of which Mr Dan JIRÁNEK and Mr Jan MAREŠ, member and alternate member of the Committee of the Regions, were proposed for appointment and appointed. In addition, by letter of 1 March 2023<sup>2</sup>, the Secretary-General of the Committee of the Regions notified the Council of the resignation of Mr Tomáš MACURA, member of the Committee of the Regions.
2. Under Article 305 TFEU, the Council appoints members and alternate members of the Committee of the Regions, acting by a qualified majority on proposals by the respective Member States.

3. In accordance with that provision and for the purpose of their replacement, the Czech Government has proposed<sup>3</sup> the following representatives of local bodies who hold a local authority electoral mandate as members of the Committee of the Regions for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 25 January 2025: Ms Dagmar ŠKODOVÁ PARMOVÁ, *Zastupitelka města České Budějovice* (Representative of the City of České Budějovice), and Mr Richard VEREŠ, *Zastupitel městské části Slezská Ostrava* (Representative of the Municipal District of Silesia Ostrava).
4. Moreover, the Czech Government has proposed Mr Jaroslav ZÁMEČNÍK, representative of a local body who holds a local authority electoral mandate, *Zastupitel města Liberec* (Representative of the City of Liberec), as an alternate member of the Committee of the Regions for the remainder of the current term of office, which runs until 25 January 2025.
5. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore invited to confirm its agreement on the text of the Decision set out in document 10087/23 and to suggest that the Council adopt that Decision as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting.
