Subject: EU Digital COVID Certificate

- Proposal for a Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council amending Regulation (EU) 2021/954 on a framework for the issuance, verification and acceptance of interoperable COVID-19 vaccination, test and recovery certificates (EU Digital COVID Certificate) with regard to third-country nationals legally staying or residing in the territories of Member States during the COVID-19 pandemic

On page 14 of document 10212/22 INIT, recital 12 should be read as follows:

“(12) In order to allow for its prompt application, this Regulation should enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.”

On page 23, the first sentence of Article 2 should be read as follows:

“This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.”

On page 28, recital 12 should be read as follows:

“(12) Given the urgency of the situation related to the COVID-19 pandemic, this Regulation should enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.”

On page 29, Articles 1 and 2 should be read as follows:

Article 1

Article 3 of Regulation (EU) 2021/954 is replaced by the following:

‘Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

It shall apply from 1 July 2021 for as long as Regulation (EU) 2021/953 is applicable.’

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in the Member States in accordance with the Treaties.”
