Subject:	Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL on a multiannual recovery plan for Bluefin tuna in the eastern Atlantic and the Mediterranean repealing Regulation (EC) No 302/2009

In document 10259/2/15 REV 2, on page 12, Article 8(7) should read as follows:

"7. ~~By way of derogation from paragraph 3 and 6, for the years 2015, 2016, and 2017, each Member State shall limit the numbers of its purse seiners not authorised to fish for Bluefin tuna under the derogation referred to in Article 13(2)b to the numbers of purse seiners it authorised in 2013 or 2014.~~ **This shall not apply to purse seiners operating under the derogation referred to in Article 13(2)b.**"

On page 19, Article 20(2) should read as follows:

"2. The flag Member State shall withdraw the fishing authorisation for Bluefin tuna and ~~shall~~ **may** require the vessel to proceed immediately to a port designated by it when the individual quota is deemed to be exhausted."
