The Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and has the honour to refer to the Council's notification of 25 April 2023 and its own notification of 7 June 2023, the latter informing the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union of the acceptance of the below mentioned legal acts, subject to the fulfilment of constitutional requirements in Liechtenstein in accordance with the second and third sentence of Article 5(2)(a) in combination with Article 5(2)(b) of the Schengen Protocol.

In accordance with Article 5(2)(b) of the Schengen Protocol, the Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union has the honour to notify the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union that the constitutional requirements regarding the following acts have been fulfilled, thereby making the acts binding on Liechtenstein:

- Directive of the European Parliament and of the Council on the exchange of information between the law enforcement authorities of Member States and repealing Council Framework Decision 2006/960/JHA
- Council Document: PE-CONS 70/22

The exchange of notes referred to above shall therefore enter into force on the date of this notification.

The Mission of the Principality of Liechtenstein to the European Union avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union the assurances of its highest considerations.
