	<ul> <li>Intention not to object to the delegated act</li> </ul>

- <u>The Commission</u> submitted the abovementioned Delegated Regulation (10262/25) to the Council on 11 February 2025 in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU and with Article 10(1) and (3) of Council Regulation (EC) No 2173/2005 on the establishment of a FLEGT licensing scheme for imports of timber into the European Community.
- <u>The Counsellors/Attachés (Agri Forestry)</u> have examined the delegated act and on 20 June 2025 agreed that there are no grounds for the Council to object to it.

- 3. It is therefore suggested that the Permanent Representatives Committee
  - recommends that the Council confirms that it has no intention to object to the delegated act and that the Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed thereof. This implies that, unless <u>the European Parliament</u> objects to it, the delegated act shall be published and enter into force on the day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union in accordance with Article 2 of the Delegated Regulation.
