<u>The Committee</u> agreed to the mandate for the second informal trialogue to be held on 17 June 2008.

The Spanish delegation introduced the following statement concerning the additives file (doc. 10269/08):

"The main purpose of the Spanish health authorities is the protection of the consumer safety, including the defence of the population groups that may be more vulnerable, including children.

The basis for the food safety, as designed at European level since the white paper on food safety, is the risk analysis, based on an independent risk assessment, which lies in the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA).

EFSA has recently evaluated the results of the study of McCann et al on the effects of certain dyes and sodium benzoate in the behaviour of children and concluded that only provides limited evidence that mixtures tested had a small and statistically significant effect on the activity and attention in some children from the general population and that the clinical significance of the observed effects also remains unclear. Moreover, since mixtures and not individual additives were tested, it is not possible to ascribe the observed effects to any of the individual compounds.

10503/08 lb 15 CAB **FR/FN**  Consequently, the inclusion of warnings on the label in this case would not be a measure of risk management based on an independent risk assessment, and we do not believe it contributes to improving the consumer protection, but can cause confusion.

We understand that any measure in this way should be taken by a comitology procedure with scrutiny after a technical discussion based on an opinion of EFSA, so we see as favourable the proposal from the Presidency that moves these labelling requirements to the Annex.

Spain believes that the adoption of the food improvement agents package is a matter of priority and it contributes as a whole to improve the consumer protection and we understand that with the proposal of the Presidency there is no reason to vote against its adoption, hence finally Spain abstain in the vote on this issue."
