Subject: Draft Council Decision on identifying the violation of Union restrictive measures as an area of crime that meets the criteria specified in Article 83(1) of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union

- Agreement on the text of the Council Decision
- Request for the consent of the European Parliament
- Decision to use the written procedure

1. Discussions at technical level on the draft Decision have taken place throughout the month of June 2022, notably in the Working Party on Cooperation in criminal matters (COPEN) on 16 June.
2. The Presidency concluded that agreement had been reached at technical level on 24 June 2022. The text prepared at technical level as revised by lawyers linguists is set out in document 10287/22.

3. **In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is requested to:**
- **confirm its agreement on the text of the Decision of the Council set out in document 10287/22;**
 - **agree to request the consent of the European Parliament on the text of the Council Decision set out in document 10287/22;**
 - **decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure and Article 1 of Council Decision 2020/430, that the Council uses the written procedure for the decision to request the European Parliament's consent on the text of the Council decision set out in the document 10287/22.**
