Subject: Proposal for a REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulation (EC) No 1071/2009 and Regulation (EC) No 1072/2009 with a view to adapting them to developments in the sector
– Outcome of the European Parliament's proceedings (Strasbourg 2 to 5 July 2018)

I. INTRODUCTION

The rapporteur, Ismail ERTUG (S&D, DE), presented a report consisting of 70 amendments (amendments 1-70) to the proposal for a Regulation on behalf of the Committee on Transport and Tourism.

In addition, political groups tabled the following amendments: S&D tabled two amendments (amendments 100-101), ECR eleven amendments (amendments 71-81), Greens/EFA one amendment (amendment 82), GUE/NGL six amendments (amendments 102-107), ENF five amendments (amendments 95-99). Fourteen amendments were tabled by more than 38 MEPs (amendments 83-94 and 108-109).

II. VOTE

When it voted on 4 July 2018, the plenary adopted amendments 1-55, 58-70 and 96 to the proposal for a Regulation. However, the draft legislative act, as amended, was not adopted¹.

Since the draft legislative act, as amended, failed to secure a majority of the votes cast, the matter was referred back to the Committee for reconsideration, pursuant to Rule 59(4)(4) of the European Parliament's Rules of Procedure, thereby not bringing the Parliament's first reading to a close.
