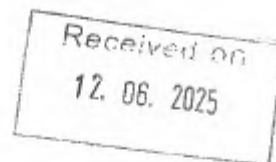

NOTE VERBALE

The Mission of Norway to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and the European Commission and has the honor to refer to the Agreement concluded by the Council of the European Union and Iceland and Norway concerning the latters' association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen acquis, signed on 18 May 1999.

The Mission of Norway to the European Union refers to the adoption of the following Regulation by the European Parliament and of the Council of the European Union:

- *Regulation (EU) 2025/12 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 December 2024 on the collection and transfer of advance passenger information for enhancing and facilitating external border checks, amending Regulations (EU) 2018/1726 and (EU) 2019/817, and repealing Council Directive 2004/82/EC.*

In accordance with Article 8 (2) (a) of the Agreement concluded by the Council of the European Union and Iceland and Norway concerning the latters' association with the implementation, application and development of the Schengen acquis, the Mission of Norway to the European Union hereby notifies, on behalf of the Government of Norway, that Norway has accepted the content of the said regulation and that, according to Article 8 paragraph 2 (c), the content of this act can become binding for Norway only after the fulfilment of constitutional requirements.

The Mission of Norway to the European Union avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and the European Commission the assurances of its highest consideration.
