- 1. On 16 June 2023, the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Council Decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union in the ACP-EU Committee of Ambassadors, with regard to amending Decision No 3/2019 of the ACP-EU Committee of Ambassadors of 17 December 2019 to adopt transitional measures pursuant to Article 95(4) of the ACP-EU Partnership Agreement (ST 10782/23).
- 2. On 20 June 2023, the ACP Working Party reached an agreement at its level on the proposal.

- 3. The Permanent Representatives Committee is invited accordingly to recommend that the Council, at one of its upcoming meetings:
 - adopt the draft Council Decision on the position to be taken on behalf of the European Union in the ACP-EU Committee of Ambassadors, with regard to amending Decision No 3/2019 of the ACP-EU Committee of Ambassadors to adopt transitional measures pursuant to Article 95(4) of the ACP-EU Partnership Agreement, as set out after finalisation by the legal/linguistic experts in document ST 10680/23;
 - order publication of the Council Decision in the Official Journal;
 - inform the European Parliament of the adoption of the Council Decision;
 - order the publication of the ACP-EU Decision, once adopted, in the Official Journal.

Following the adoption by the Council, a draft ACP-EU Decision will be sent to the ACP side for adoption by the ACP-EU Committee of Ambassadors by exchange of letters.
