Subject: Draft REGULATION OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL amending Regulations (EU) 2024/1689, (EU) 2018/1139 and (EU) 2023/1230 as regards the simplification of the implementation of harmonised rules on artificial intelligence (Digital Omnibus on AI) **(first reading)**
- Adoption of the legislative act

1. On 19 November 2025 the Commission submitted its proposal¹, based on Article 114 TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Central Bank delivered its opinion on 13 March 2026².
3. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 18 March 2026³.
4. The Committee of the Regions delivered its opinion on 7 May 2026⁴.

5. On 16 June 2026 the European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal⁵. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council.
6. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 30/26, as an "A" item at a forthcoming meeting.
7. The statements for the minutes of the Council meeting are set out in the Addendum to this note.
8. If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the Presidents of the European Parliament and of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.
