NOTE VERBALE

The Mission of Norway to the European Union presents its compliments to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and the European Commission and has the honor to refer to the Agreement between the European Community and Iceland and Norway concerning the criteria and mechanisms for establishing the state responsible for examining a request for asylum lodged in a member state or in Iceland or Norway, signed on 19 January 2001.

The Mission of Norway to the European Union refers to the adoption of the following Regulations by the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union:

- *REGULATION (EU) 2024/1351 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 14 May 2024 on asylum and migration management, amending Regulations (EU) 2021/1147 and (EU) 2021/1060 and repealing Regulation (EU) No 604/2013*
- *REGULATION (EU) 2024/1359 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 14 May 2024 addressing situations of crisis and force majeure in the field of migration and asylum and amending Regulation (EU) 2021/1147*
- *REGULATION (EU) 2024/1358 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 14 May 2024 on the establishment of 'Eurodac' for the comparison of biometric data in order to effectively apply Regulations (EU) 2024/1351 and (EU) 2024/1350 of the European Parliament and of the Council and Council Directive 2001/55/EC and to identify illegally staying third-country nationals and stateless persons and on requests for the comparison with Eurodac data by Member States' law enforcement authorities and Europol for law enforcement purposes, amending Regulations (EU) 2018/1240 and (EU) 2019/818 of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Regulation (EU) No 603/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council*

In accordance with Article 4 paragraph 4 of the Agreement between the European Community and Iceland and Norway concerning the criteria and mechanisms for establishing the state responsible for examining a request for asylum lodged in a member state or in Iceland or Norway, the Mission of Norway to the European Union hereby notifies, on behalf of the Government of Norway, that Norway has accepted the content of the said regulations as described in the notifications of the European Commission of 17 May and 12 June 2024.

The Mission of Norway to the European Union avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the General Secretariat of the Council of the European Union and the European Commission the assurances of its highest consideration.
