## **INFORMATION NOTE**

	- Abdulbasit Abdulrahim v. Council of the European Union and Commission of
	the European Communities

- 1. By an application notified to the Council on 29 May 2009, Abdulbasit Abdulrahim has brought an action before the Court of First Instance in the above-mentioned case for the annulment of Council Regulation (EC) n° 881/2002 imposing certain specific measures directed against certain persons and entities associated with Usama Bin Laden, the Al-Qaida network and the Taliban as amended by Commission Regulation (EC) n° 1330/2008 of 22 December 2008<sup>1</sup> and / or Commission Regulation (EC) n° 1330/2008.
- 2. The applicant invokes the following grounds in support of his claim for annulment of the contested Regulation:
  - a) Breach of the right to a fair hearing and to effective judicial protection,
  - b) Breach of the right to property,
  - c) Breach of the right to respect for private and family life.

- 3. The applicant also claims damages for loss of earnings, loss of profits, loss of business opportunities and other non-material damage.
- 4. The applicant has applied for legal aid in order to cover the costs of the proceedings.
- 5. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed Ms Emer FINNEGAN and Mr Richard SZOSTAK, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
