- 1. The European Atomic Energy Community (Euratom) and its Member States are Contracting Parties to the Convention on the Nuclear Safety. In accordance with Article 5 of the Convention, each Party must submit prior to each review meeting referred to in Article 20, a report on the measures it has taken to implement the obligations of the Convention.
- 2. The Report on the implementation of the obligations of the Euratom, as set out in doc. 10821/22, covers the period from June 2019 to April 2022 and will be examined in the forthcoming 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Review Meeting of the Contracting Parties, to be held in Vienna, 24 to 31 March 2023.
- 3. The report was prepared in consultation with the Member States, in the spirit of the agreed "Guidelines on cooperation in the framework of international conventions to which the European Atomic Energy Community and its Member States are Parties" (doc. 12807/15). The consultation took place by means of an informal silence procedure that ended on 29 June and was not broken.
- 4. The Delegations are requested to take note of the Report as set out in doc. 10821/22.
