**Statement by Belgium, France, the Netherlands, Romania and Slovenia on the disclosure of  
the document setting out a progress report on the European Peace Facility in relation to  
Ukraine**

Belgium, France, the Netherlands, Romania and Slovenia oppose the publication of the latest version of the document as proposed by the GSC.

Document WK 7935/25, produced by the EEAS, sets out a progress report on the European Peace Facility in relation to Ukraine. It contains extensive information on the delivery of military equipment to Ukraine.

Its disclosure, even in part, poses a twofold risk, namely in terms of defence and international relations – two public interests that could justify a refusal to disclose information under Article 4(1) of Regulation 1049/2001.

Indeed, at a time when numerous informational attacks are targeting support for Ukraine, the information disclosed in this way could be misinterpreted or even instrumentalised in a manner detrimental to the interests of the Union and to the protection of the abovementioned interests.
