The SCA discussed the proposal on a Regulation amending the CAP strategic plans and horizontal regulations as regards fertilisers and took note of the information from the Presidency and the comments from delegations and the Commission.

The Chair noted that there was a qualified majority in favour, subject to some scrutiny reservations. He asked delegations to indicate by close of business on Wednesday, 17 June, if they could lift those reservation<sup>1</sup>, allowing the sending of a letter to the European Parliament indicating that the Council could accept the Commission proposal without amendments if the parliament agreed to do the same.
