Subject: Draft Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council on a multiannual recovery plan for Bluefin tuna in the eastern Atlantic and the Mediterranean, and repealing Council Regulation (EC) No 302/2009  
Adoption of the legislative act (LA + S)

---

1. On 24 April 2015 the Commission sent its proposal<sup>1</sup>, based on Article 43(2) TFEU, to the Council.
2. The European Economic and Social Committee delivered its opinion on 1 July 2015<sup>2</sup>.
3. The European Parliament adopted its position at first reading on the Commission proposal on 23 June 2016. The outcome of voting in the European Parliament reflects the compromise agreement reached between the institutions and should, therefore, be acceptable to the Council<sup>3</sup>.

4. The Permanent Representatives Committee is therefore asked to confirm its agreement and to suggest that the Council:
- approve the European Parliament's position, as set out in PE-CONS 14/16, as an 'A' item at a forthcoming meeting;
  - order that the statement in the addendum to this note be entered in the minutes of that meeting and published in the Official Journal of the European Union.

If the Council approves the European Parliament's position, the legislative act will be adopted.

After being signed by the President of the European Parliament and the President of the Council, the legislative act will be published in the Official Journal of the European Union.
