Subject: Case before the General Court - Russia restrictive measures:
– Case T- 283/22 (Vadim Nikolaevich MOSHKOVICH v. Council)

DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (25.07.2022)

1. By an application notified to the Council on 23 May 2022, Mr Vadim Nikolaevich MOSHKOVICH has brought an action, pursuant to Articles 263 and 264 TFEU, for the annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/397 of 9 March 2022 amending Council Decision 2014/145/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine¹; and of Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/396 of 9 March 2022² implementing Council Regulation (EU) 269/2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine³, in so far as those acts include the applicant in the list of persons and entities made subject to the restrictive measures.

2. The applicant invokes four pleas in law in support of its application:
- infringement of the obligation to state reasons, breach of the rights of defence and of the principle of effective judicial protection,
 - manifest error of assessment,
 - breach of the applicant's fundamental rights to property and freedom to conduct a business,
 - breach of the principle of non-discrimination.
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
