Subject: Adjustment of a cross-reference – Commission Regulation amending Annexes VIII and IX to Regulation (EC) No 999/2001 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards chronic wasting disease in live cervids - (draft SANTE/11090/2021)

Dear Ambassador, Dear Honourable Chair,

I am referring to the above-mentioned draft Commission Regulation, which was sent to the European Parliament and the Council on 7 July 2022 in accordance with Article 5a(3) of Decision 1999/468/EC laying down the procedure for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission as amended by Decision 2006/512/EC (Reference : Document D076837/3 - Regulatory Procedure with Scrutiny).

I wish to inform you that a minor adjustment needs to be made in the text before its adoption by the European Commission, in order to correct a non-substantive/obvious mistake.

The issue is about point 1.(b) of the annex to the draft Regulation, which adds a new Section C in Annex VIII, Chapter C to Regulation 999/2001. As voted in the Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed (the PAFF Committee), the reference in point 2 to the '*Member States listed in point 1.1*' is not appropriate, as there is no such point 1.1 in the new Chapter C, Section C. The list of Member States which is referred to is actually to be found in point 1.1 of Chapter A, Section C.

The text will therefore be adjusted as follows before adoption and publication in the Official Journal:

(b) in Chapter C, the following Section C is added:

SECTION C

Urine hunting lures from cervids

1. The movement into the Union of consignments of urine hunting lures derived from cervids originating in Norway shall be prohibited.
2. The manufacture, placing on the market and use of urine hunting lures derived from cervids originating in the Member States listed in **Chapter A, section C**, point 1.1 shall be prohibited.;

The Comitology Register will be updated with the revised version of the Commission Regulation, after its publication.
