Statement by Belgium

"Belgium fully supports a balanced and ambitious trade agenda, which remains vital for growth, jobs and competitiveness in Europe. This trade agenda should also ensure a level playing field and contribute to strengthening the competitiveness of our agricultural sector, while preserving high quality standards, and take into account the cumulative impact of trade agreements.

Even though Belgium regrets the new volume of 50,000 tons, in addition to the existing 20,000 ton TRQ for poultry meat under the DCFTA, Belgium considers that the timely implementation of the negotiated solution is necessary to halt further import increases. Belgium accepts therefore the agreement with Ukraine amending the trade preferences for poultry meat.

Given the great importance of creating a level playing field with Ukraine, Belgium insists on the correct implementation of the DCFTA, especially regarding the swift follow-up of the comprehensive strategy on Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures (SPS) and on strengthening cooperation with regard to animal welfare and antimicrobial resistance (AMR)."
