Subject:	Case before the General Court of the European Union - Russia restrictive measures: - Case T-256/22 (V. F. Yanukovych v. Council) - Application for annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/376 of 3 March 2022 and Council Regulation (EU) 2022/375 of 3 March 2022

DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (24.08.2022)

1. By an application notified to the Council on 25 May 2022, Mr Viktor Fedorovych YANUKOVYCH has brought an action, pursuant to Articles 263 and 275 TFEU, for the annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/376 of 3 March 2022 and Council Regulation (EU) 2022/375 of 3 March 2022, insofar as they affect the Applicant;
2. The applicant invokes three pleas in law in support of its application:
 - Alleged failure to verify the Ukrainian authorities respect of the applicant's rights of defence and to effective judicial protection;
 - Alleged manifest errors of assessment in determining the fulfilment of the designation criteria;
 - Alleged breach of Right to Property.

3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
