Any other business

9. Organisation of future work

The Presidency urged delegations to limit the number of “any other business” items for the “Agriculture and Fisheries” Council meetings and, insofar as possible, table these items at SCA level instead.

The Presidency then informed the SCA about the next SCA meeting on 1 September 2026 and the “Agriculture and Fisheries” Council meeting on 13 July 2026.

Regarding that Council meeting:

- Hungary requested two public items under “any other business”, on the “Joint Declaration of the Ministers of Agriculture of the Visegrad Group and Bulgaria, Croatia and Romania on the effective management of agricultural crisis situations within the CAP framework and in the wider context”, and on the “Joint Declaration of the Ministers of Agriculture of the Visegrad Group and Croatia and Romania on the cooperation in the field of bioeconomy and tackling weather extremes”;
- Italy requested a public item under “any other business”, on the budget for the annual work programme for 2027 to promote agricultural products.
- The SCA agreed these three AOB items, as well as the discussion item on “Women in Agriculture”, would be taken in public session in accordance with Article 8(2) of the rules of procedure of the Council.
