Subject:	Case before the General Court of the European Union - Case T-296/24 - Application for annulment - restrictive measures Ukraine territorial integrity

DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (08.08.2024)

1. By application lodged with the General Court on 12 June 2024, Mr Igor Albertovich Kesaev, has brought an action pursuant to Article 263 TFEU for the annulment of (1) Council Decision (CFSP) 2024/847 of 12 March 2024 amending Decision 2014/145/CFSP concerning restrictive measures against actions that undermine or threaten the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine and (2) Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/849 of 12 March 2024 implementing Regulation (EU) No 269/2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine, insofar as these acts concern the applicant.
2. In support of his action the applicant submits four pleas:
 - plea of illegality:
 - a. violation of the presumption of innocence and the right of defence;
 - b. violation of the principle of non-discrimination
 - c. violation of the principle of proportionality;
 - d. violation of the principle of legal certainty and the principle of legitimate expectations;

- violation of the obligation of motivation and error of appreciation;
- violation of the principle of proportionality;
- violation of the principle of non-discrimination

3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisers in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
