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Subject: COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) .../... of XXX amending Annexes II, III and IV to Regulation (EC) No 396/2005 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards maximum residue levels for acibenzolar-S-methyl, aqueous extract from the germinated seeds of sweet *Lupinus albus*, azoxystrobin, clopyralid, cyflufenamid, fludioxonil, fluopyram, fosetyl, metazachlor, oxathiapiprolin, tebufenozide and thiabendazole in or on certain products

- *Decision not to oppose adoption*

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1. On 28 July 2021, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 11127/21 + ADD 1 + ADD 2) in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision No 1999/468/EC<sup>1</sup>, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC<sup>2</sup>, laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
2. The Working Party of Agricultural Attachés (Phytosanitary Matters) considered, through an informal written consultation<sup>3</sup>, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
