- Application for annulment of Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/429 of 15 March 2022 and of Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/427 of 15 March 2022

DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (24.08.2022)

1. By an application notified to the Council on 8 June 2022, Mr Vladimir RASHEVSKY has brought an action, pursuant to Article 263, for the annulment of (i) Council Decision (CFSP) 2022/429 of 15 March 2022 amending Decision 2014/145/CFSP concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine; and of (ii) Council Implementing Regulation (EU) 2022/427 of 15 March 2022, implementing Regulation (EU) No 269/2014 concerning restrictive measures in respect of actions undermining or threatening the territorial integrity, sovereignty and independence of Ukraine, in so far as those acts include the applicant in the list of persons and entities made subject to the restrictive measures;

2. The applicant invokes a single plea in law in support of its application:
 - manifest error of assessment
3. The Director-General of the Council Legal Service has appointed **DELETED** and **DELETED**, legal advisors in the Council Legal Service, as the Council's agents in this case.
