Subject:	COMMISSION DELEGATED REGULATION (EU) .../... supplementing Directive (EU) 2024/2841 as regards setting the QR code on the physical version of the European Disability Card and setting the QR code and establishing common technical specifications that ensure the security of the physical version of the European Parking Card for persons with disabilities, as well as interoperability matters - Decision to use the written procedure - Decision to extend a time limit

1. On 1 July 2026, the Commission notified the above delegated regulation to the Council in accordance with the procedure set out in Article 290 TFEU, and with Article 7(7) and Article 8(7) in conjunction with Article 14 of Directive (EU) 2024/2841¹.
2. In accordance with Article 14(6) of Directive (EU) 2024/2841, the Council has two months to object to the delegated regulation, i.e. until 2 September 2026. That period for expressing an objection can be prolonged by two months.

3. During the consultation of Member States, delegations indicated that due to the overlap of the two-month deadline with the summer holiday period they would need additional time in order to assess the proposed delegated regulation. Considering the limited possibilities to take a decision on the item at the level of the Permanent Representatives Committee and Council before the end of the two months period for objection, delegations requested an extension of the deadline to raise objections.
4. In view of the above, the Permanent Representatives Committee is called to:
 - a) invite the Council to decide to extend the deadline for raising objections to the delegated regulation by two months in accordance with Article 14(6) of Directive 2024/2841;
 - b) decide, in accordance with the first subparagraph of Article 12(1) of the Council's Rules of Procedure, that, in view of the urgency of the matter, the Council uses the written procedure for the adoption of the decision to extend the deadline for raising objections to the delegated regulation. Such a request is also justified by the absence of a Council meeting scheduled for August 2026.
 - c) The Commission and the European Parliament are to be informed accordingly
