Subject:	Preparation of the first meeting of the EU-US informal expert group (MLA, extradition) - List of experts designated by the Member States

DOCUMENT PARTIALLY ACCESSIBLE TO THE PUBLIC (26.10.2022)

At the EU-US Ministerial Meeting on Justice and Home Affairs on 23 June 2022, the EU and the U.S. endorsed the creation of the EU-US informal expert group on mutual legal assistance (MLA) and extradition. It is expected that the first meeting of the group will take place in Q4 of 2022 or Q1 of 2023.

In the Internal EU rules for work in the EU-US informal expert group, it is set out that each Member State shall designate two experts, with substantial practical experience of the application of the EU-US agreements, for a pool of experts, providing information on their areas and levels of expertise.

In this light, and in view of preparing the first meeting of the EU-US informal expert group, the Member States have been requested, by note 10842/22 of 4 July 2022, to designate ‘*two experts with substantial practical experience of the application of the EU-US agreements. They shall provide a CV of the experts designated, which shall contain information on their areas and levels of expertise.*’
