1. On 6 August 2021, the Commission submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 11251/21 + ADD 1 REV 1 + ADD 2) in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision No 1999/468/EC<sup>1</sup>, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC<sup>2</sup>, laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
2. The Counsellors/Attachés (Food) considered, through an informal written consultation<sup>3</sup>, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
