- (1) On 1 October 2015, the Council adopted Regulation (EU) 2015/1755.
- On the basis of a review of Regulation (EU) 2015/1755 by the Council, the entry concerning one person included in the list of natural and legal persons, entities and bodies subject to restrictive measures, as set out in Annex I to that Regulation, should be deleted.
