### **Statement by the Commission**

“The Commission understands that this common position of the EU and its Member States will be delivered by EUDEL to New York on behalf of the EU and its Member States, as agreed by the Council. The Commission also understands that the agreement of the Council is based on the understanding that Belgium, as the Member State holding the rotating Presidency of the Council, will also deliver this common position on behalf of the Member States during the first substantive session of the UN Ad Hoc Committee.

In view of the common political objective to ensure unified and effective EU and MS engagement in the upcoming discussions at the UN and in a spirit of compromise, the Commission will not oppose such an understanding in the framework of the discussions in the framework of the first substantive session of the Ad-Hoc Committee to draft the terms of reference for a United Nations framework convention on international tax cooperation taking place from 26 April to 8 May 2024.

The Commission would like to recall and underline in this context that all acts of external representation, including the delivery of statements on behalf of the EU in an international organisation and the coordination meetings held between EU and MS delegates in the framework of discussions or negotiations in these international organisations, are in accordance with Article 17(1) TEU the institutional prerogatives of the Commission, with the exception of such acts pertaining to agreements falling exclusively or predominantly within the common foreign and security policy of the Union, where it is the High Representative who represents the Union externally according to Article 27(2) TEU. Moreover, in accordance with Article 221(1) TFEU, Union delegations in third countries and at international organisations shall represent the Union.

If a common position is endorsed by the Council, Commission and the Delegations of the Union have therefore a mandate under the treaties (and under the General Arrangements of 2011) to express the position on behalf of the EU and its MS, without prejudice to the right of Member States to make a statement in their national capacity, if there are elements that fall under their own competences. Possible statements by Member States need to be aligned with statements on behalf of the EU and its Member States in accordance with the principle of sincere cooperation.

The Court of Justice has emphasized that consistent practice by Union institutions that is not in accordance with the EU Treaties ‘cannot alter the rules of the Treaties that the institutions are obliged to respect’ (Case C-687/15 Commission v Council, EU:C:2017:803, para. 42 and most recently on 9 April 2024 in Case C 551/21 European Commission v Council of the European Union).


Therefore, while not opposing the underlying understanding in this very specific instance, this “double delivery” approach by EUDEL and Presidency should not constitute a precedent for future practice and the Commission reserves all its rights in this regard.”
