- On 27 July 2021, <u>the Commission</u> submitted for scrutiny by the European Parliament and the Council the above draft Regulation (ST 11118/21 + ADD 1) in accordance with Article 5a (3)(a) of Council Decision No 1999/468/EC¹, as modified by Council Decision No 2006/512/EC², laying down the procedures for the exercise of implementing powers conferred on the Commission.
- <u>The Counsellors/Attachés (Food)</u> considered, through an informal written consultation³, that there are no grounds for the Council to oppose the adoption of the draft Commission Regulation.
